Sometimes nouns can't be made plural with an 's' or 'es,' they must be changed in a different way. We call these nouns irregular. Here are some examples of irregular and tricky-to-spell nouns.

this - these	nucleus - nuclei
that - those	echo - echoes
knife - knives	fungus - fungi
life - lives	scissors - scissors
wife - wives	potato - potatoes
half - halves	tomato - tomatoes
loaf - loaves	volcano - volcanoes
man - men	mosquito - mosquitoes
foot - feet	wolf - wolves
child - children	ox - oxen
person - people	mouse - mice
tooth - teeth	moose - moose
cactus - cacti	deer - deer
die - dice	sheep - sheep
hero - heroes	calf - calves
